



ATVs are allowed on all trails except for the Porter Trail - be prepared. Most ATV riders in this area are considerate and will stop for you.

Please leave your dogs at home. Please stay on established trails - no trail blazing. You may disturb a Forest Service experiment if you stray off the trails.

The Rock Ledge Loop is rocky and has some water to cross and a few steep hills. Middle Trail has one muddy area and a hill, not so steep as Rock Ledge. Roberts Pond Trail is hilly but not as difficult as Rock Ledge. Porter, Old Limerick and Blueberry Trails are very easy. The CC Road and Chicken Farm Road are wide dirt roads. The bridge over Cooks Brook is wide and safe to cross.

The Rock Ledge Loop is marked on the right hand side of the trail with blue paint on trees. There is also blue surveyor's tape in some places. One vertical line marks the trail. Two horizontal lines signal an intersection ahead.
