### How much does a membership cost?


- Youth \$15.00/year (riders under 18)

HEP is adjacent to the Massabesic Trail System – almost. There is a short trail that connects the park to the trails, with the entrance at the base of the jump course. For years, HEP maintained agreements with the abutting landowners to allow riders to pass through. However, these agreements have expired, property has changed hands, and it is now posted.
